Reflecting on progress

Renecting on progress

At the end of each standardised assessment my teacher gives me feedback on what I did well and also what I need to do to improve. I also reflect on my own result compared to my target grade and address the areas of improvement.

Repeats—in Year 12, I may be able to repeat some of my Year 11 modules to gain a better overall result. Students pay for all repeats.

Controlled Assessments—internal assessments undertaken in school un-

der exam conditions. The results contribute to my final GCSE grade.

- Summative Assessment (GCSE/GCE exams, Christmas and Summer Tests, End of Topic Tests, 5 Standardised Tests)
- Self and Peer Assessment

- Homework (Written, Learning, Research, Practical)
- Marking for Improvement, Feedback and Reflection (Assessment Cover Sheet)



Key Stage 4 Tracking Progress

- Based on your KS3 Assessments (Using Maths and Communication Levels, Assessments throughout the year, PTM and PTE Results), you will be given a Personalised Target Grade for each subject
- Your teacher will share your Personalised Target Grade with you for each subject
- You will record your Target Grade for each subject in your diary
- Your 5 Standardised Test results will be put on SIMS and benchmarked against your Target Grade
- You will record your 5 results in your diary and record whether you are Above, On or Below Target
- At the end of the Standardised Assessments you will complete your Cover Sheet by reflecting on how you performed in your assessment. Your teacher will give you feedback on your achievements and what you may need to improve on.
